PLAYERS

- Must comply with the rules of the game, show good sportsmanship and observe fair play at all time
- Show respect for fellow team members, management, opponents and officials
- Show respect for both our own and opponents facilities and equipment
- Recognise that the team is the star and not the individual
- Be aware that you have been chosen to represent your town and to behave accordingly
- Be punctual for both matches and training and inform managers if unable to attend either
- Pay match and training fees on time
- Most importantly to enjoy your football.

PARENTS

- Avoid remonstrating with match officials and representatives from opposing teams
- Respect all decisions of the team managers
- Accept that your child is playing for themselves and not for you
- To try and provide transport as and when needed and to inform managers if unable to do so
- Watch as many matches as possible and share in your child's experiences
- Encourage all team members

CLUB

- To try and improve a players skill and technique
- To provide emergency first aid in case of accident
- To provide personal accident and public liability insurance (policy details available on request)
- To keep you informed on all general matters
- Provide a child protection policy
- Provide a safe and enjoyable environment
